For their 2009 Improving Accessibility Beacon year, Nottingham City Council and Nottinghamshire County Council are hosting a series of workshops to share experiences of the most successful and innovative aspects of the region's accessibility planning work.

The **NOMAD+** data sharing partnership workshop is the fourth and final workshop in the programme. This workshop will look at how we share accessibility mapping, MOSAIC data and other information with our partners (through the NOMAD+ web portal) and use this information to improve access to services. The workshop will provide delegates with the opportunity to try out our NOMAD and NOMAD+ online mapping and information services. The session will be followed by a networking lunch when staff from the City Council's Transport Strategy and GIS Teams will be on hand for further discussion and questions.

This workshop is aimed at local authority officers, particularly those involved in accessibility planning, public transport and transport planning. It is also suitable for colleagues in the education, health, leisure and employment sectors responsible for planning the delivery of services.
